1) Tuesday 7th of May at 2pm

The Old Rectory at Hearne Lane, Hodnet TF93NG Our host is Sarah Riley.

3 ½ acres of gardens, that were created over 45yrs by John and Elizabeth Ravenscroft. These include formal gardens, a walled garden, a large pool with stepping stones as well as lawns and wooded areas. Points of interest are the collections of azaleas, magnolias and peonies. After several years of neglect, the present owners are working to restore the gardens.

Maximum of 25 people no minimum.

N.B. There is only parking for 8 cars so we might need to car share. Cost £8.50 per head to include tea/coffee and cake

2) Tuesday the 11th of June at 2pm

Ruthall Manor at Ditton Priors WV166TN

Our host is Linda Clarke who has explained that as she is approaching 90, she is unsure how much longer the garden will be opening.

Offset by a mature collection of specimen trees, the garden is divided into intimate sections, carefully linked by winding paths. Highlights include the front lawn that is flanked by borders, a gravelled art garden and a ha-ha. Clematis and roses scramble through an eclectic collection of wrought-iron work, unique pottery and secluded seating. A large horse pond features Candelabra Primulas, Iris Siberica and bog plants.

Wildegoose Nursery Walled Garden at Lower Millichope SY79HE Our host is Laura Willgoss.
